LIBRARIAN/WEB MASTER: Scott Wachlin not present.

Sickness /Health. Ron Hanson was at the meeting and is doing well. Carl Ross had a knee replacement in March, and is also up and about doing fine.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussion on a truck. It was brought up that we are incorporated, if we need to rent a truck to pull the Fairbanks. We could possibly use the truck dolly out of Leesa's house to pull the Fairbanks short distances, as long as we had a heavy duty truck to pull it.
