You are covered for an incident involving a parade spectator for bodily injury and property damage. You do not have coverage involving an incident with a non-EDGE parade participant, such as a person operating another parade exhibit. It is the same, as when you participate in an EDGE branch parade. You do not have coverage involving an incident with another branch member, who is also participating in the parade. Similarly, in the case of a non-EDGE event, you do not have overage for an incident involving a non-EDGE member, who is also participating in that event... Bottom line, don't hit a parade member, because you are not covered. Spectators are covered, by the EDGE Insurance.
