Board Member, in the Central Coast Branch #27, and is very active in all of the aforementioned clubs. Carl is a real showman, in that his displays are always antique engines driving something. It could be something, as simple as a saw, water pump, grinder, or a feed cuter. His display engines are extra ordinary, such as an Emerson Brantingham 1 ½ HP or a Foos Junior 2 ½ HP, and he also displays large engines, such



as the 6 HP Witte or a 4 HP Bullseye, both are Hit & Miss engines.
