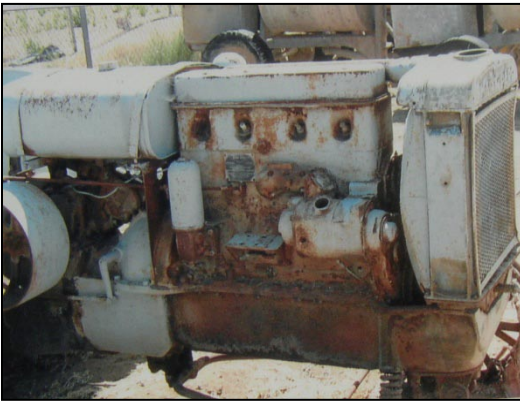
1946 Farmall "H"
