If you are completing any forms for EDGE&TA you must include you branch number on those as well. The branch number issued when your club joined EDGE&TA is how your branch agreed to be identified during the application process. This speeds up any process concerning your branch. Please make sure you are updating your officers' information form on the website. It is important for the directors to have up-to-date contact information for each branch. It is also important from an insurance stand point. If the officer's information is not up-to-date, the officers are not covered by the D&O insurance provided to the officers for each branch. I know some of you have had difficulty with the website after you updated your information. Please be patient with us. I appreciate all the constructive criticism. The feedback we receive from the members is how we make improvements. We know everything isn't perfect and it doesn't always run like a well-oiled machine, but we are working each day to improve it.
