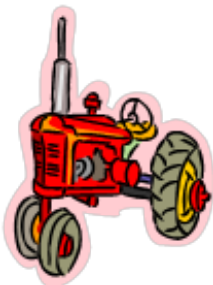

## DOWN – HOME – COOKING

This is a collection of receipts by Rusty Relic's Members Past & Present.

### Country Gravy

4 table spoons flour

4 table spoons pan drippings

1 tea spoon of salt

Dash pepper

2 cups of milk

Blend flour in hot drippings in skillet, add salt & pepper. Cook until light brown, stirring constantly. Add milk, gradually, stirring constantly. Use a whisk to help remove any lumps. Cook until gravy is smooth and thick. If it gets to thick, add a little milk and stir until smooth.

### GERMAN PANCAKES

2 cups of flour

1 ½ tsp. baking powder

1 table spoon sugar

1 tsp. salt

4 eggs

milk

bacon

Separate eggs. Mix flour, baking powder, sugar and egg  yolks. Add enough milk to make a thick batter. Fold in stiffly beaten egg  whites. Fry bacon (on 1 side only) in frying pan. Turn bacon, then spread thin layer of batter over bacon. Flip pancake to brown second side. Brown as would any pancake. Serve warm with jelly or syrup.
