DOWN – HOME – COOKING

This is a collection of receipts by Rusty Relics Members Past & Present.

APPLE BROWN BETTY

1/2 cup sugar
2/3 tsp. cinnamon
1/3 tsp. salt
3 cups dry stale bread crumbs, fine texture
6 pared diced apples
5 tbsp melted butter or margarine

In a cup combine sugar, cinnamon, and salt thoroughly. With a layer of apples in a casserole dish, sprinkle with partial sugar mixture. Repeat layers with sugar mixture and top with bread crumbs. Drizzle melted butter over crumbs. Cover and Bake at 375 degrees for 40 minutes. Uncover casserole for last 10 minutes.

MEXICAN MIX CASSEROLE

1 (15oz.) can chili
1 (12 oz.) can whole kernel corn
1 (8 oz.) pkg. grated cheddar cheese
1-2 cups crumbled corn
or nacho chips

HEAT oven to 350 degrees. Open the can of chili and empty into a casserole dish. Open the can of corn and pour out liquid by partially blocking the top of the can with lid. Add the corn to the top chili. Add grated cheese to the casserole. There is no need to mix up the casserole. Crumble chips in your hands over the top of the casserole and press them down gently, part way into the mixture. Bake for 20 minutes. Remove from oven using potholders. Serve casserole with extra whole chips.
