#### **OFFICERS REPORT:**

The letter explained that an insurance carrier was found that will provide "participant liability coverage" for us, both for the case of one of our members participating in a community parade and for an incident involving another EDGE member at our shows. Much discussion followed. This fills the gap that we have not been able to cover before. However, it does come with an increased insurance cost of \$5.00 per member. This is a small price to pay for additional coverage that we will be getting.

Bill Forbes made a motion to increase our 2019 dues by \$5.00 to offset this insurance increase, second by Ron Zega. Motion passed. The motion increase will affect everyone, except seniors over 80 years of age. There dues will remain the same. Copies of the EDGE letter was made available to everyone, after the meeting. # Insurance Update, September 2018, By Dick Tombrink, NW Regional Director

Outside of one accident, we have had no other accidents or other insurance claims this show season. That is good news. Thanks to all the EDGETA members for keeping safety foremost in your mind. In the last newsletter I talked about switching to a different insurance carrier next April. The new policy includes participant liability coverage which we do not have now. This provides us liability insurance coverage when we participate in a community parade and have an incident where one of our members is involved with another non EDGETA member of the parade. Also, at an EDGETA show, if an EDGETA member is involved in an incident with another EDGETA member they will have liability insurance coverage. The EDGETA insurance cost will go up \$5, to cover this additional participant liability insurance coverage. This means that instead of paying \$8 as we did this year, next year we will pay \$13 for

This means that instead of paying \$8 as we did this year, next year we will pay \$13 for insurance. Next year the total EDGETA National dues (\$4) and insurance will be \$4 + \$13=\$17. For our branch we will probably increase our member dues to cover the additional insurance cost. Other branches will need to decide what works for them. From those that I have talked to, everyone seems comfortable with the additional cost for this additional coverage. It fills a need in our coverage that we did not have up to now. At \$5 the additional the cost is minimal. With this new insurance carrier, the deductible will go up from \$1000 to \$2500. However, the EDGETA board voted to pay the \$1500 difference if a branch member is involved in an incident. So, in effect there is no change in the \$1000 deductible for the branches. As we get closer to the renewal time, if there are any other changes to our coverage I will let you know. The renewal is April 15th. Any changes will probably be negotiated in the couple months prior to renewal. If you have any comments or questions regarding the new insurance policy that we will adopt next year, please email me or call me (406-967-6687). ## **Annual and Regional Shows:**

Morrie Robinson (NW Advisor) explained the recent method of the divisions of the United States for the selection of branches to host the shows. Now, the US is divided into three major regions to host the annual National Show: Eastern Region, Central Region, and Western Region. There are 6 Regional divisions: NE, SE, NC, SC, NW and SW. The year that a branch hosts the National Show, there is no Regional Show in that Region for that year. All of the other 5 regions have Regional Shows in their respective regions.

The <u>2019 National Show</u> will be hosted by Branch 114 in Red Bluff, California in April 26-28, 2019, which is in the Southwest Region.

There will be no SW Regional Show in 2019....see you in California.
