I spoke with Mike at Tractoropolis in Fresno and he said from the number stamped on the engine block it is a 1949. It needs a correct one wire generator and tractor front tires to be original. It has car radials on the front now. No one has really modified much of anything that I can tell. It still has the 6 volt positive ground electrical. It has a 4 cylinder engine with the distributor on the front of the engine and 4 speed transmission. It runs and the hydraulics work to raise and lower the grader. The little trailer is so cute, as I mentioned it looks like old military surplus, but you would know more than me. They are asking \$2,500 for the complete tractor, grader and trailer. They would like to find a tractor enthusiast that would enjoy it for what it is. If you have any questions please call, text or email.
