There were 71 tractors, 8 engines, an ice cream maker, and a nice display by two Branch 8 members and also a display by a Branch 30 member, Carl Ross. Many LPG tractors and rare tractors displayed that you don't see very often. A great group of people, many stories and laughs. On our return trip we stopped in Roswell, New Mexico at the International UFO Museum and Research Center to visit some aliens. It was very interesting. Leaving New Mexico and entering Arizona our first-ever experience of a monsoon. Many vehicles parked on either side of the freeway as you could barely see the front of your vehicle. 15 YEARS AGO 2002


